

# HAIL DAMAGE CHECKLIST

---

✓ Use this checklist each time you look at hail damage on roofs or siding:

- Arrive early if you can
- Walk around site
- Neighborhood assessment (not number of roofers, but look at siding and screens)
- Vegetation
- Window screens/shutters
- Air conditioning unit
- Fences/deck
- Utility box covers
- Thickness of:
  - siding
  - downspouts
  - gutters
  - fascia
- Window wraps
- Fascia
- Siding
- Roofing
  - slope
  - size
  - year and condition
  - type of roofing material and manufacturer
  - closeup photos with and without damage
  - vents
- Exterior modifications through the life of the roof (painting, partial replacement, etc.)
- Ask who was on the roof
- If contractor was on the roof ask them how they know it is hail damage

## Remember...

Unless there are holes in the roofing, a roofing evaluation cannot be performed while on the ground or on a ladder at the eave.
